The key points and guidelines for the Virtual Internship are given below:

1. The Virtual Internship shall be considered as *Mini Project/ Internship (Virtual or Physical/ Project-Based Learning)* as mentioned in the syllabi of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> semesters.
2. The internship will be completed **during** the preceding year from the semester when its presentation has to be made. (For example, if the internship presentation is of 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, the virtual internship may be


completed during the entire 1<sup>st</sup> year, provided it does not interfere with the student's regular class schedule).

3. As per the National Credit Framework (NCrF), 01 credit will be awarded for every 30 hours of practical work. The Virtual Internship will be of minimum 60 hours duration and will carry 02 credits.
4. Evaluation of the internship will be conducted preferably jointly by the industry and the university to ensure comprehensive assessment of students' practical knowledge and skills.
5. Upon successful completion, the industry partner will issue a completion certificate, and the Institute will assess the student's work in the subsequent semester.
6. If the students opt for Virtual Internship (from among the Mini Project or Internship), students will be required to undertake the Virtual Internship preferably with the industries approved by the University (as listed above), as the University has signed MoUs with them after meticulous deliberations regarding the enhancement of the skill set and employability quotient of the students. However, the students are free to undertake internships from any other recognized organization as per their choice.
7. The above provision will be effective for the students admitted in the session 2025-26 and onwards.

In view of the above, it is requested that the information regarding the virtual internship opportunities may kindly be circulated among all students of your institution. Students who undertake these virtual internships may be formally recognized by the college and their participation appropriately accepted with academic credits, in accordance with university norms and guidelines.


Your kind cooperation and necessary action in this regard will greatly encourage student participation and further strengthen industry-academia collaboration, as envisioned under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
